For Credit and Online Offerings

-Online Driver's Education

Get that golden ticket to bypass the DMV driving test when your child turns 16! This course consists of an online asynchronous educational course followed by at least two hours of in-person driving time with the instructor. The driving time must be scheduled and paid for separately with the instructor, at a cost of \$70 per hour. The driving portion may be scheduled for any time in the summer, fall, or spring, as long as the student has a valid permit and has completed the online course.

*Please note this course will have an additional \$140 cost that will be paid directly to the instructor when your students schedules their required 2 hour driving sessions.

-For Credit Course-Geometry

In geometry, students learn to appreciate Euclidean geometry as a deductive system. Accordingly, the students study formal logic early in the course and use it throughout. Starting with undefined terms, postulates, and definitions, the students follow the progressive development of theorems to create a mathematical structure with rich aesthetic and practical value. In building this axiomatic structure, they improve their ability to recognize and organize the various relationships among points, lines, triangles, polygons, and circles in a plane. This course also includes the study of geometry with coordinates and the solid geometry of common shapes.

*Pre-requisite of completion of Algebra 1 and approval from Math department is required for students to officially enroll.
